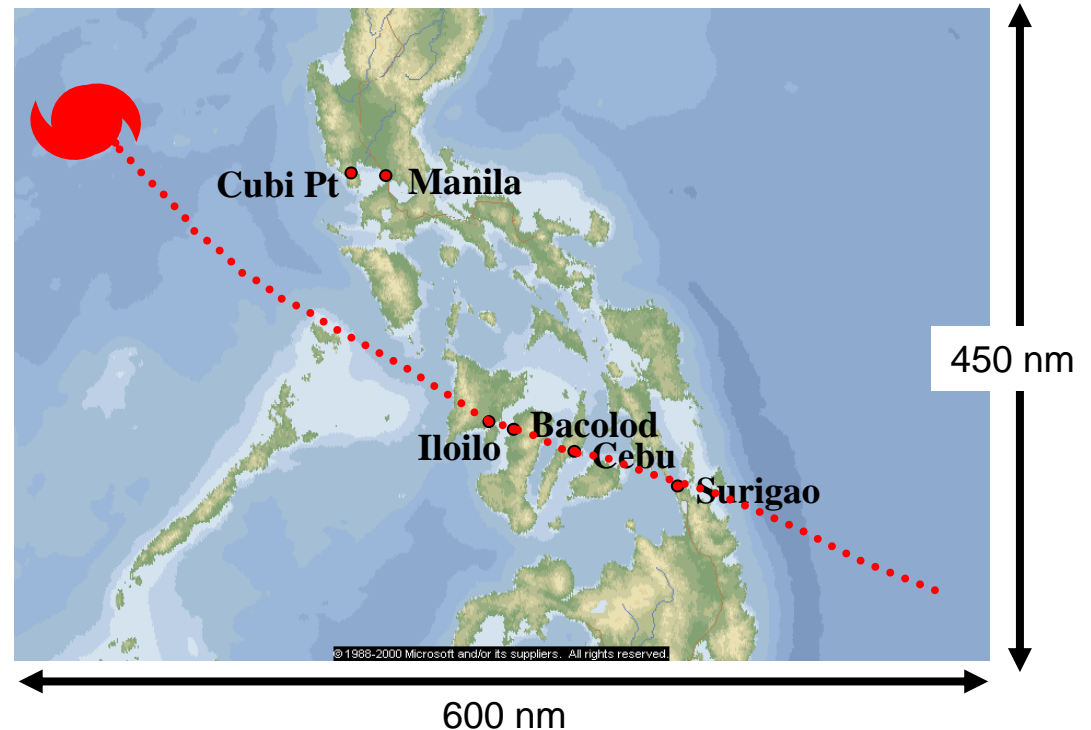


Scenario

- Super Typhoon Babette struck the central Philippines islands 600 km southeast of Manila
- More than 20,000 people have been killed and over 500,000 homeless
- PASOLS Member Nations will conduct multi-national planning for the HA effort
- PASOLS Member Nations will limit its operations to conducting minimal essential life sustaining support including distribution of supplies



Scenario (continued)

Assumptions

- Typhoon causes significant destruction of multiple islands requiring Multi-national Humanitarian Assistance Operation
- Philippines seeks coalition assistance to relieve suffering and assist in delivery of HA supplies
- Host nation (HN) provides force protection for all HA supporting nations
- Deploying units self-sufficient for first 3 days

Scenario (continued)

Mission

Conduct a humanitarian assistance operation to provide: life-saving, search & rescue; stabilization actions at the point of need (100 sq mi.); support base for relief agencies; and local fresh water delivery / generation

Description of Phases

- Pre-Crisis:
 - Emergency Planning
 - NGO Involvement (What can they do/What can't they do?)
 - Crisis Assessment & Preparation (the Typhoon is out there, we know it's coming, let's do some preparation)
- Crisis:
 - Deployment
 - Deploy of forces
 - Establish command and control
 - Open PODs
 - Relief Operations
 - Evacuation operations (injured, tourists, etc.)
 - Delivery of food, water, basic shelters, and medicine
 - Restore infrastructure
 - Operate PODs
 - Sustain distribution of HA supplies
- Post-Crisis:
 - Transition
 - Prepare for redeployment
 - Conduct transition of relief efforts to host-nation
 - Redeployment
 - Redeploy task force after transition
